AWARENESS TRAINING For Prescribers and Dispensers of Controlled Substances

Wednesday, Sept. 18 noon to 1:30 p.m.

New training requirement for health care providers currently licensed by the state of Michigan to prescribe or dispense controlled substances

All individuals who are currently licensed in Michigan to prescribe or dispense controlled substances must complete a one-time training on "opioids and other controlled substances" covering the following topics:

- use of opioids and other controlled substances
- integration of treatments
- alternative treatments for pain management
- counseling patients on the effects and risks associated with using opioids and other controlled substances
- the stigma of addiction
- utilizing the Michigan Automated Prescription System (MAPS)

• state and federal laws regarding prescribing and dispensing controlled substances

• security features and proper disposal requirements for prescriptions

This requirement takes effect Sept.1, for initial licenses and the first renewal cycle after the promulgation of this rule for controlled substance license renewals.

The Sept.18 lecture has been developed by the Beaumont Pain Management Education Committee to meet this requirement.
